He or she will receive an award letter, an iWatch and a 2 month internship contract with EY Training Center as an appreciation of his/her efforts. In addition to that, the overall top student out of all the participating universities will receive a sponsorship for a professional certificate of choice from Ernst & Young - Abu Dhabi, worth AED 15,000.
