AAU OVERVIEW

Al Ain University of Science and Technology is licensed and its degree programs are accredited by the Commission for Academic Accreditation of the Ministry of Education- Higher Education Affairs in the United Arab Emirates.

The University has two major campuses. One is located in Abu Dhabi, the capital city of the UAE, and another in Al Ain, also known as the Garden City.

Al Ain University of Science and Technology offers 21 undergraduate programs, 5 graduate programs and 1 professional diploma through the colleges of Engineering and Information Technology, Pharmacy, Business Administration, Communication and Media, Law, and Education, Humanities and Social Sciences. The University has conducted several studies with the intent of launching more degree programs as and when they obtain approval from the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research.

The College of Pharmacy has obtained international certification from the American-based Accreditation Council of Pharmacy Education (ACPE). It is the first and only university in the UAE to get this kind of accreditation Likewise; the College of Law received full accreditation from the Supreme Council for Evaluation, Research and Higher Education in France (HCERES).

TUITION FEES

ADMISSION TO THE UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS

The admission policy for undergraduate programs at the University is based on obtaining the certificate of secondary education or its equivalent, regardless of age, race, origin and ethnic background.

General conditions for admission

The student:

1. must have a high school certificate or an equivalent at the rate of at least 60% in all disciplines except the Bachelor of Science in Pharmacy, the rate is 70%.
2. should obtain a certificate of foundation year in the case of getting a rate less than 60% in the high school certificate.
3. must meet the requirements set by the College that s/he wants to join.
4. should have an English proficiency certificate. At least a score of 500 for the TOEFL and Band 5 for the IELTS, except for the students of Bachelor of Communication and Media (Journalism- Advertising- Public Relations), a score of 450 for the TOEFL is required or Band 4.5 for the IELTS. However, this requirement is excluded from students in disciplines that are taught in Arabic: Law, Arabic Language and Islamic Education Teacher Preparation, Applied Psychology, Applied Sociology and Special Education.



The documents are the property of the University and the student is not entitled to claim them afterwards.

Admission requirements and the necessary documents for registration

Science and Arts Stream

Any student who has a General Secondary certificate with an average of 60% or above may enroll at AAU, and must include the following documents with his/her application form:

- A General Secondary school certificate/ transcript, or its equivalent attested by the Ministry of Education in the UAE. (An attested copy may be submitted).
- A valid English Language Proficiency certificate of no less than 500 in the TOEFL ITP, or Band 5 in Academic IELTS.
- A copy of a valid passport.
- Two passport-sized photographs.
- A health certificate.

Technical Stream

Students with the rate of 65% are eligible to enroll in the University, but should consider the conditions of each college, for each one of them has its specific requirements. A student should submit the following documents along with an application form:

- Technical high school transcript (a certified copy is accepted).
- An equivalent certificate to the technical high school certificate issued by the UAE Ministry of Education.
- The documents mentioned in the admission requirements for high school students.

Students transferring from other educational institutions

Students enrolled in other universities are allowed to move to Al Ain University of Science and Technology, provided that the previous University or College is certified by the UAE Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research.

The conditions of admission for student transfer

The student must:

1. meet the admission requirements of the University and College requirements in order to join,
2. have completed at least 9 credit hours in the previous University or College,
3. be enrolled in a regular study program in the previous University or College.

Required documents:

- The documents mentioned in the admission requirements for high school students.
- Transcripts of the courses studied by the student and their descriptions, which must be certified by the previous University or College.
- If a student is studying at a University from outside the State, the transcript must be certified by the Foreign Ministry of that country and by the Embassy of UAE.

Students with diploma degrees

Students with diploma degrees can advance to Al Ain University of Science and Technology, provided that the University or College which granted them the degrees is recognized by the UAE Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research. Moreover, a student must meet the general admission requirements of the University as well as the admission requirements for the College s/he intends to accede.

The requirements along with the application:

- The documents mentioned in the admission requirements for high school students.
- Transcripts of College or University that indicate the number of hours of study and degrees in addition to a description of the courses studied by the student.
- The student must also submit a certificate equivalent to the diploma issued by the UAE Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research if a diploma is issued by a state other than the State of UAE.



ADMISSIONS TO GRADUATE PROGRAMS

General conditions for admission:

A student must have:

- a Bachelor's degree or its equivalent from a university accredited by the UAE Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research, and if the certificate is from out of State, it should be duly authenticated.
- an equivalent of the Bachelor degree from the UAE of Ministry of Higher Education if the certificate has been issued outside the State,
- the original transcript, and if out of the State, it must be duly authenticated,
- a copy of the passport,
- a copy of the UAE ID,
- two photographs.

Master of Science in Clinical Pharmacy

Unconditional admission:

1. A Bachelor's degree or equivalent from a University accredited by the UAE Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research.
2. GPA of at least 3 out of 4 or an equivalent to the Bachelor's degree.
3. A valid certificate in English and a degree of not less than 550 in TOEFL ITP, 79 in TOEFL iBT, 213 in TOEFL CBT, 6 in IELTS or an equivalent. The exception to this requirement applies to students whose mother tongue is English or finished a Bachelor's degree from an institution where English is the language of instruction in an English-speaking country.

Conditional admission:

1. If a student scored 530 in TOEFL ITP or has an equivalent, s/he will be granted a conditional admission, provided that s/he:
 - gets at least a score of 550 in TOEFL or Band 6 in IELTS by the end of the first term of joining the program,
 - is registered for no more than 6 credit hours in the first term of joining the program,
 - obtains a GPA of no less than 3 out of 4 in the first six credit hours of the approved program.
2. If a student obtains a Bachelor's degree with a GPA between 2 and 2.99 out of 4 or an equivalent and meets the conditions of the English Language proficiency requirements as set out above, s/he can advance to the program, provided that the student:
 - is registered in the first semester of joining the program with no more than 9 credit hours,
 - obtains a GPA of 3 out of 4 in the first 9 hours of the approved program.



Masters in Law (Public – Private)

Unconditional admission

For a student to be accepted into the Master of Private or Public Law program, s/he should have:

- a Bachelor degree or an equivalent from a recognized university in the State of UAE,
- a GPA of 3 out of 4 at an undergraduate level,
- a valid certificate in an English proficiency exam, of at least 450 in TOEFL ITP or Band 4.5 in IELTS, or an equivalent.

Conditional admission

1. If a student obtains a GPA between 2 and 2.99, s/he will be granted a conditional admission, provided that s/he:
 - is registered for no more than 6 credit hours in the first semester of joining the program,
 - gets at least 3 out of 4 or an equivalent in the registered program during the first semester.
2. If a student holds a Bachelor degree in Law, Sharia or in Police Science and Law, s/he must have studied at least 65% of the requirements for graduation in the Bachelor of legal courses, and does not need to study for more than 12 credit hours as catch-up courses that are taught during the first year of joining the program, and which are not calculated in the GPA.

Students transferring from outside the University

The courses can be accounted from another accredited University, provided that:

- the transfer student meets the program requirements s/he wishes to advance to,
- the number of hours transferred from another program does not exceed 9 credit hours.



Master of Arts in Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL)

Unconditional admission

To be accepted in the TESOL Master's program, the applicant must:

1. hold a Bachelor's degree or an equivalent in English/Linguistics/Translation/English Language and Literature/English Language from a university accredited by the UAE Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research,
2. obtain a GPA of at least 3 out of 4 (very good) or an equivalent at a Bachelor's level,
3. have a valid certificate in an English language proficiency exam, not less than 550 in TOEFL ITP, 79 in TOEFL iBT, 213 in TOEFL CBT or Band 6 in IELTS or an equivalent. A student is exempted from this requirement if his/her mother tongue is English or has obtained a Bachelor's degree from an institution where English is the official language of instruction in an English speaking country.
4. In all cases, every student must undergo a personal interview with the program coordinator after submitting a written article.

Conditional admission:

1. If a student obtains the TOEFL ITP certificate with a score of 530 or an equivalent and has an average of at least 3 out of 4, s/he will be granted a conditional admission, provided that the student:
 - gets a score of 550 in TOEFL or Band 6 in IELTS by the end of the first semester of joining the program,
 - registers for no more than 6 credit hours in the first semester of joining the program, and gets a GPA of 3 out of 4.
2. If a student obtains the TOEFL ITP certificate with a score of 550 or an equivalent and has a cumulative average from 2 to 2.99, s/he will be granted a conditional admission, provided that s/he registers 9 credit hours per semester of joining the master's program and gets a GPA of 3 out of 4. A student may take these 9 hours in one semester, two semesters (3 + 6) or even three semesters (3 + 3 + 3).
3. If an applicant obtains the TOEFL ITP certificate with at least a score of 530 or an equivalent and has a cumulative average from 2 to 2.99, s/he will be granted a conditional admission, provided that the student registers a maximum of 6 credit hours in the first semester of joining the program, obtains a GPA of 3 out of 4 with at least a score of 550 in TOEFL or Band 6 in IELTS by the end of the semester of joining the program.

Admission requirements for the Professional Diploma in Teaching program

For admission to the Professional Diploma in Teaching program, the applicant must:

1. hold a Bachelor's degree or an equivalent in a specialization from a university accredited by the UAE Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research,
2. obtain a GPA of at least 2 out of 4 (passing grade) or an equivalent at a Bachelor's level.

Requirements for admission into the MBA program

General conditions

For admission to the MBA program, the applicant must:

1. hold a Bachelor's degree or an equivalent from an accredited university by the UAE Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research,
2. obtain a GPA of at least 3 out of 4 or an equivalent at a Bachelor's level,
3. have a valid certificate in an English language proficiency exam not less than 550 in TOEFL ITP, 79 in TOEFL iBT, 213 in TOEFL CBT or Band 6 in IELTS or an equivalent.

A student is exempted from the last condition:

- if his/her mother tongue is English or has obtained a Bachelor's degree from an institution where English is the official language of instruction in an English speaking country, or
- if s/he has obtained a Bachelor degree from a University where the language of instruction is English with at least a score of 500 in TOEFL ITP or an equivalent.



Conditional admission

1. If a student obtains the TOEFL ITP certificate with a score of 530 or an equivalent and has an average of at least 3 out of 4, s/he will be granted a conditional admission, provided that the student:
 - gets a score of 550 in TOEFL or Band 6 in IELTS by the end of the first semester of joining the program,
 - registers for no more than 6 credit hours in the first semester of joining the program, and gets a GPA of 3 out of 4,
 - gets a GPA of 3 out of 4 in the first 9 hours of the approved program.
2. If a student obtains a Bachelor's degree with a GPA between 2 and 2.99 from 4 or an equivalent, and meets the conditions of the English language certification, as set out above, s/he will be granted a conditional admission, provided that the student:
 - registers for no more than 9 credit hours in the first semester of joining the program,
 - gets a GPA of 3 out of 4 in the first 9 hours of the approved program. A student may study the 9 credit hours in two semesters (3 + 6) or three semesters (3 + 3 + 3).



Non-business BA graduates

In addition to the previous points, students with Bachelor degrees in specializations unrelated to business administration can advance to the MBA program, taking into account the following conditions:

- Enrolling in a number of prerequisite courses as specified by a department.
- Taking 4 catch-up courses, and can only be exempted from all remedial materials that have been studied at a Bachelor's level.

Transfer students

Course work completed at another accredited university may be accepted in the MBA program with the following conditions:

- Credit towards the MBA degree must be at the postgraduate level and must have received grades of at least B.
- Credits to be transferred must relate to the content of the courses and/or be comparable to those offered at the University. Copies of catalog course descriptions or course syllabi are required to process requests for the transfer of credits.
- The maximum approved transfer credits toward an MBA program must not exceed 12 hours.

Student listener admission

An individual can be registered in a course that does not enable him/her to obtain master's degrees, for these students are not enrolled in the College, but wish to study specific disciplines. Thus, a student listener:

- may not get a degree without applying for admission into the master's program in accordance with the conditions mentioned at the top of the page,
- must obtain the approval of the Dean and the Coordinator of the master's program

Visiting students

The students enrolled at other universities are allowed to register in courses offered by Al Ain University of Science and Technology, however, in order to be accepted as visiting students, they must attach a letter from their original universities along with the application, taking into account the following:

1. a letter from the student requesting to be allowed to study at the University as a student visitor,
2. an official letter from the original University with the mention of the courses a student is allowed to register.

GRANTS AND HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE

The aim of the University is to reward the students through the provided scholarships, whether they excel academically, or for their extramural excellence. Furthermore, the University provides humanitarian assistance to those students who face fiscal conditions that prevent them from completing their first university degree.

Grants

1. The University offers scholarships to high school graduates, according to the following criteria:
 - a. Full scholarship for the first top five students.
 - b. Students who score **95%** and above, whether in the scientific or literary stream, a scholarship equivalent to **30%** discount fee of the registered credit hours will be granted.
 - c. Students who score between **90% - 94.9%**, whether in the scientific or literary stream, a scholarship equivalent to **25%** discount fee of the registered credit hours is granted.
2. The University offers academic excellence and scholarship in the amount of **30%** discount fee of the registered credit hours for a student who successfully completes a minimum of **15** credit hours in the first or second semester and obtains a GPA of at least **3.6**.
3. The University offers scholarships for brothers and relatives currently enrolled as described below:
 - a. Each of the siblings (with the exception of the first) will be granted **20%** off tuition of the registered credits.
 - b. The parents, sons, daughters and spouses enrolled in the University are entitled to discounts.
4. The University offers scholarships to students who lose their breadwinner during their studying years. A **50%** discount of the tuition will be granted and will continue until graduation. The grant is governed by the following rules:
 - a. The provision of a duly certified death certificate.
 - b. A student has not received a scholarship from any other official institution in the State.
 - c. The student will only benefit from the grant in the semester following the semester s/he applied.
 - d. The student does not have any other financial sources to enable him/ her to continue his/ her university studies.
5. The University offers a grant equal to **50%** discount fee of the registered credit hours for children of employees of the university faculty and staff, except for graduate students.
6. The University offers scholarships for one semester for outstanding students in extracurricular activities.

Humanitarian aid

The University offers humanitarian aid in the form of scholarships for students who cannot continue their studies for financial reasons.

«Contribution» Fund

Al Ain University of Science and Technology insists to find a permanent source of care for the needy students, and in this case a fund called 'Contribution' has been established, where donations and grants from companies contribute to assist the financially needy students. Accordingly, a Committee for the Fund has been set up by a resolution of the Board of Trustees of the Foundation along with the rules for governing its work.

Conditions for obtaining scholarships and humanitarian aid:

1. These grants are limited to undergraduate students only and does not include graduate students.
2. These grants cover the fees for the first and second semester only.
3. Applications are completed at the Deanship of Student Affairs with the beginning of semesters I and II only.
4. The minimum cumulative GPA for humanitarian aid is 2.5, with the exception of academic excellence and scholarship of excellence in high school.
5. To continue the scholarship for excellence in high school, the cumulative average should not be less than 3.6 and 15 credit hours per semester have been completed.
6. To continue with the academic excellence grant, the cumulative average should not be less than 3.6, and 15 credit hours per semester have been completed.
7. Grants and discounts do not apply to English level exams, registration fees or charges of activities.
8. Grants and discounts do not apply to students funded by outside parties.
9. The student should not collect two scholarships at the same time. The highest of the two will be considered eligible for the grant.
10. The grant is not applicable on repeated courses.
11. A granted student must pay the financial obligations on time.
12. No student shall be entitled to a grant during the semester where s/he was given an academic warning.
13. No student shall be entitled to a grant if due to disciplinary punitive.
14. Grants and discounts are not given retroactively.
15. Grants and discounts are not applied on summer courses.
16. No student shall be entitled to postpone studying during the grant period.
17. Students with grants are expected to be an example of commitment to the rules of conduct at the University.

STUDENT SERVICES

STUDENT SERVICES

Student Affairs Deanship

Through the Deanship of Student Affairs, Al Ain University of Science and Technology presents many services that contribute to the University's interaction with students on the one hand, and the interaction of the students with the local community on the other hand. These services are performed through many units and committees:

Student Activities Unit

The Student Activities Unit seeks to activate the role of the students in extracurricular activities by organizing various events and activities that are scientific, cultural, artistic, athletic and healthy. They tend to meet the students' extracurricular and academic needs as well as developing various skills to positively hone their personalities..

Psychological and Social Counseling Unit

The Psychological and Social Counseling Unit tends to follow-up with the students in terms of non-academic problems and to provide appropriate solutions, as well as individual and collective advice for students, while maintaining the highest level of confidentiality. As for the new students, the unit communicates with them to help them overcome the difficulties they may encounter with the beginning of their university years.

Health Care Unit

Through the University, the clinic offers health services, primary nursing care and simple emergency situations, except for critical situations where a sick student is transported to the nearest hospital by ambulance for a practitioner to examine a situation and to complete the necessary tests.

Career Development Unit

The unit provides several services to help students determine possible alternatives and develop the skills necessary for the labor market. It also guides the students in identifying their interests and abilities in possible occupations by holding workshops on career planning, resume writing, interview techniques and job search. The University also participates in exhibitions of particular jobs and occupations.

Office of Alumni Affairs

The main purpose of the Office of Alumni Affairs is to promote the spirit of communication between the University and its graduates on the one hand and between the alumni themselves, on the other hand, in line with the University's vision and mission. It also aims to promote the professional and personal relations between the University and its alumni. To achieve its objectives, it builds bridges with different institutions to identify new graduates in employment, in line with the University's vision of linking academia to the society.



Scientific and Training Committee

This Committee is concerned with the scientific and training activities of interest to students in their fields and help to develop the skills within their academic fields.

Cultural and Social Committee

This Committee is interested in creating student cadres capable of collective action through social and cultural activities that can be literary or artistic. It also helps students to undertake social responsibilities and aims its activities to develop their relationships with each other and with the University environment. Moreover, these activities help in creating student cadres capable of teamwork.

Information Technology Committee

This committee works to regulate activities relating to information technology and e-learning, distance learning and other related technologies.

Health Committee

The committee aims to raise awareness of health and literacy for students with health information and facts by organizing healthy activities on global events, attending and participating in health activities.

Sports Committee

This Committee aims to promote and develop sports talent by organizing sports competitions among college and university students, in addition to students from outside the University. There are also fitness courses and sport competitions between the colleges.

Itinerant Committee

Scouting is a voluntary educational movement, open to everyone, which aims to contribute to youth development, physically, mentally, socially and spiritually in order to be positive contributors in their communities. This committee aims to prepare and rehab young people by performing training camps during the academic year.



Recreational Facilities

Gym and Health Club

There are qualified instructors at the gym and health club to supervise students in all sports. The gym offers students a chance to practice their chosen sports including tennis, volleyball, basketball, handball, soccer, in addition to many other facilities that help gain fitness and agility. The times have been determined as allowable for both sexes to enter the lounge and health club very carefully to give the students as much time as possible to benefit from these facilities.

Lounges

The University has lounges where students can spend their time during their break between lectures to give them the opportunity to practice many social activities.

The Multi-purpose Theatre

The University has a theatre that could be used as a hall for discussing research, meeting with students, managing seminars and cultural events, performing plays, etc.

The Mosque

There are two mosques on campus for students, one in the male section and another in the female section, which helps students to pray in time easily.

Educational Support Units

Bookshop

The bookshop provides the students with the required books for their university courses, where they purchase copies of books or some books at the beginning of every semester easily. It also provides other services for students, such as stationery sets..

English Language Centre

The English Language Center at the University helps students to improve their English, and ensure faculty members in the center to provide an attractive learning environment where learning and teaching are fun and educational, taking into account the individual differences and diversity when teaching to ensure their success.

Hypothetical Court

This form of court is a simulation of a real court in both civil and criminal matters, and is conducted in a classroom designed as a court where appropriate issues are chosen carefully, and sets out to students to perform different judicial roles (judges, prosecutors, defense ... etc.) Eventually, the students are evaluated according to their performance level.



Student Recruitment Unit

The unit defines the University's community in terms of academic programs, diverse specializations and through visits to schools, universities and various institutions and participation in educational fairs through which the unit gets inquiries about undergraduate programs from prospective students. It also provides them with advice and guidance on appropriate specialties to their preferences and the requirements of the labor market.

As for the students enrolled in the University, the unit tends to resolve their problems within official channels in cases of the students' desires, such as transferring from one major to another, postponing and/ or suspending courses, or entirely dropping out of the University, in order to identify the causes and to find the appropriate solutions to each case.



Library

The library provides print and electronic sources of learning, as well as extension services and loan, reservation, etc. There are more than 50,000 scientific and informational materials available in the library, including books, periodicals, and multimedia. The library participates in a number of databases and electronic journals, such as tracking library and cataloguing collections using the American classifying and cataloguing rules, in addition to the benefits of the Library of Congress classification system. All of the computerized library services use an integrated system, known as the Symphony System, which facilitates quick access to indexes in the library and beyond. Moreover, the library has 17 halls for public debates and 53 computers for Internet use.
