Blood Donation Campaign for Thalassemia Patients at Al Ain University

In response to the call made by His Highness Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Vice-President and Prime Minister of UAE, Ruler of Dubai for donating blood to thalassemia patients, Al Ain University of Science and Technology, in collaboration with Tawam Hospital's mobile unit, organized a two-day blood donation campaign for thalassemia patients. AAU faculty members, students, and administrative staff responded to the campaign.

Professor Ghaleb El Refae, AAU President, said that the campaign comes in answer to the initiative started by His Highness Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Vice-President and Prime Minister of UAE, Ruler of Dubai to donate blood to thalassemia patients.
