Islamic Talk on Hijri New Year

The Community Engagement Committee, in collaboration with the Deanship of Student Affairs, organized a religious seminar entitled “The Prophet’s Hijra: Lessons Learnt” presented by Dr. Maher Haswa, faculty member at the College of Law, in the attendance of faculty, staff, and students.

Dr. Maher narrated the story of the Prophet’s (PBUH) ‘hijrah’ (migration) from Makkah to Al Madinah and the lessons learnt. He also highlighted the significance of trusting in Allah and planning in order to attain success and overcome obstacles.
