AAU Marks the 43rd UAE National Day

The AAU three-day celebrations marking the 43nd UAE National Day were launched at AAU's both campuses in Al Ain and Abu Dhabi. The celebrations include heritage-based performances, poetry recitals and interactive activities. The AAU President, Prof. Ghaleb El Refae, and Prof. Abdelhafid Belarbi, AAU Vice President, in addition to an audience of special guests and students attended the kick off ceremonial event.

The event began with the UAE National anthem and a recital from the Holy Quran. The event also included activities such as poetry recitals, traditional dances, and heritage exhibits in commemoration of the occasion.

On this occasion, Prof. Ghaleb El Refae, mentioned that celebrating the UAE 43nd National Day carries deep and lasting connotations.
