Arabic Language Symposium and its Contemporary Challenges on the Occasion of an International Day on the Mother Language in Al Ain University

The Deanship of Students Affairs at the Al Ain University of Science and Technology organized a symposium, on both campuses, under the rubric "The Arabic Language and its Contemporary Challenges" on the occasion of an International Day on the Mother Language. The symposium was collaborated with with the Ministry of Culture and Youth and the Federation of Authors and Writers, and accompanying it was the opening of the Art Symposium, which got together some 30 art works, in which five students from AAU in Abu Dhabi participated in an activity under the theme entitled: Creativity

The AAU Assistant Dean of the Students Affairs, Dr. Iyad Abdel Majeed, explained that the Arabic Language has gone through different situations and faced multiple challenges. He too
