## Al Ain University organizes the "Knowledge and Talent Market" to enhance the skills of school students.

The Student Affairs Deanship (Abu Dhabi campus) organized an initiative titled "Knowledge and Talent Market" for private school students in the secondary level, aiming to enhance the value of knowledge and talent among school students and provide an interactive environment that encourages learning and innovation.

The initiative included various theatrical performances presented by a group of school students, in the presence of Dr. Amer Qasim, Vice President of the University (Abu Dhabi campus), Dr. Nuha Hamada, Deputy Dean of Student Affairs, and several deputy deans.
